Educated in law, history, philosophy, and economics, he became one of the founders of modern science in sociology and studied society and its systems. Weber defined the modern bureaucracy as a goal-oriented organization and shared six characteristics. Everything is a hierarchy with written rules and professional division of work, progress is based on achievement and has resulted in an efficient and non-personal organization. Max Weber defined the six characteristics of bureaucracy as a formal hierarchy, rule-based management, division of work, progress focused on achievement, and efficient organization and personality. Weber's theory, developed at the turn of the 20th century, helped define the economic and political system created by the highly intensive authority of the ternary rulers and their supporters. They defined many institutions of the twentieth century. The authority of the bureaucracy has vested interest in the position, not the person, and the authority passes the level of the hierarchy based on the agreed function. The bureaucracy depends on written rules and communication. Effective bureaucrats rely on rules based on a reasonable review of the problem and the development of the most effective way to achieve the goal. Successful bureaucrats regularly review organizational diagrams, employee policies, notes, and methodologies (such as lean production technology) to improve procedures and policies to improve efficiency and results consistency.
